

Fran Marshall's Books

Fran Marshall, who passed away in June 2013, was an independent ESL resource consultant and author of ESL reader workbooks. She acted as an ESL resource consultant and workshop presenter for the Etobicoke Board of Education from 1973 to 1998. In 2001, Fran was awarded the TESL Ontario Pin for her outstanding contribution to ESL. Fran's practical publications for ESL teachers include *Thirty Minutes to Review! Challenging Opening Activities for ESL Classes* and *The Early Bird Special: A Potpourri of Opening Activities for Adult ESL Classes*. Additionally, she published many ESL textbooks and CDs. The Fran Marshall Memorial Library, hosted on the TESL Ontario website, contains all of Fran Marshall's books.
